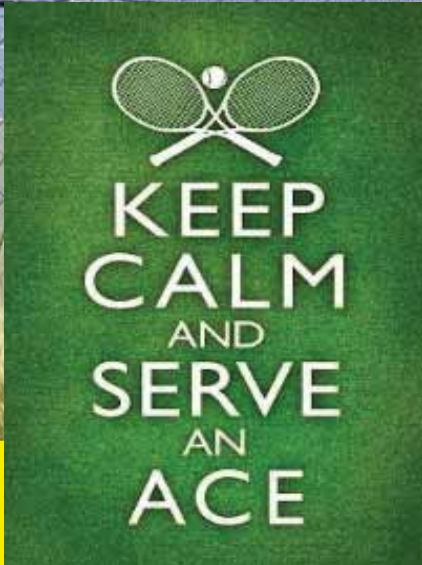

UP FOR A CHALLENGE?

MONDAY NIGHTS Courts 5 & 6 will be reserved from 7-9:30pm
for Challenge matches.
Court 5 will be for doubles. Court 6 will be for singles.
(no gender preference)

Here's how it works:

1. Sign in at the Clubhouse, then put your name on the board at the court with the time you sign up. You must sign in at the clubhouse first!
2. You must provide your own balls.

On court 5 - First four players (male or female) will play a set of doubles. Spin for serve/side. First to 6, no ad scoring, change sides every 3 games.

-Winning team stays on the court and challenges the next two players signed up on the board. Players may opt to change up partners, but both sides must be in agreement.

-If you are waiting for the next match, you must be at the court ready to play at the end of the conclusion of the previous match.

- If there are not enough players for doubles, then you may play singles.

On Court 6 – First two players (male or female) will play a set of singles. Spin for serve/side. First to 6, no ad scoring, change sides every 3 games.

-Winning player stays on the court and challenges the next player signed up on the board.

-If you are waiting for the next match, you must be at the court ready to play at the end of the conclusion of the previous match.
